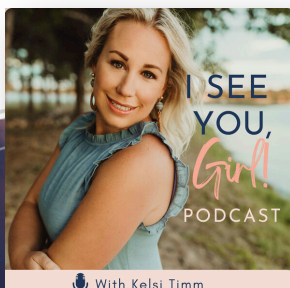


“A Story of Divine Kindness Through Faith-Full Friends”
