On that day I (Tracy) was informed I was being released from my job due to "Pandemic related financial cutbacks." Two hours after sharing that news with Debra, we received a call from the owners of the home we were living in, letting us know that they were selling the house. In a single day I lost my job and we lost our home. We recognized the changes we were facing were clearly a divine interruption, but we have struggled, at times, with our heart response to what He is doing.


