- Tracy is scheduled for Gallbladder surgery on April 16. Pray for a safe procedure and a quick recovery.



An Essential Conversation About The Church

We are living in an era of remarkable change in the way the Body of Christ, the Church, manifests itself in society, especially in the West. These changes began before the COVID pandemic, but were surely accelerated by it. Whether you are a faithful participant in a local church, serve in a leadership capacity, or are




a member of a church staff – these new expressions of church need to be acknowledged and discussed. The following 4 steps serve as a helpful guideline to facilitate that discussion.

- 1) Every generation inherits a version of the church, and what we inherit is just that, a culturally informed version of the church. We need to honestly and candidly discuss the forms, customs, and traditions that are not essential, but may have come to define "church" in our minds.
- 2) We need to examine the New Testament Church with fresh eyes. Observe the core characteristics, functions, behaviors, and values of the NT body of Christ. What has been lost that needs to be reclaimed.
- 3) With love and grace, we need to re-imagine what a fresh expression of church in our setting might look like, and courageously seek to be that expression of Church, representing Jesus in fresh ways to the lost.
- 4) The conclusions we draw and the changes we make will result in a new expression of the Church in our context. The next generation, however, will soon be wrestling with the Church we entrust to them. In this cycle of renewal the Church is ever timeless and timely.




